- Review Duties and Responsibilities of RC's - We are in desperate need of RC's, we have roughly a dozen RC's now. With a membership of 428 members and only a dozen RC's to put rides on for our members is very hard. With What does a RC do. The official duties and responsibility of a Road Captain include simpling leading, assisting, planning, and organizing closed HOG chapter rides. Your responsibility is to follow the chapter guide lines, keep current of all HOG efficiencies, keep your eyes open for all riding, and attitudes of the members in the group. The members in the group include the Road Captain, Wing and Tail all have responsibilities. The overall mission of the Road Captains is to pursue the safety and enjoyment of the members, prospects and the ladies of Harley during rides. What are some of the responsibilities?
 1. Be proactive, we have several RC's here. More RC's the more variety of rides
 2. RC's will be actively participating in group rides, plan routes, use all the current chapter hand signals
 3. Meet candidates and riders before going out on a ride. You really need to know who you are taking out on the ride to understand their abilities and how you may have to tailor your ride that day depending on what type of riders you have,
 4. Be positive and enthusiastic of all the riders, create a safe riding environment. Riding motorcycles should be fun, it should not be difficult. Again a few may need a refresher, that's why I have the welcome rides if weather permits
 5. Look at the ride through the eyes of the experience, understand that there are different riding styles
 6. They are some responsibilities they are you must have a motorcycle license, liability insurance, current national hog members, and local HOG membership,
 7. If you want to be a Road Captain, you need to say, Hey I want to be a Road Captain what do I need to do? Usually you will have a mentor that will take you out and give you some information that is needed. Once you do a check ride, the other RC's will ride with you and you will be approved by the Head Road Captain and Primary

Officer. So, if you are interested in being a RC, come see me, any of the other RC's or the primary officers

Assistant Road Captain – Matt Allen

Road Captain Orientation Rides:

- These will be scheduled 1-2 times per month, weather permitting, and includes an ice cream stop
- Select RC guidelines covered first as a refresher, followed by a briefing and shakedown ride afterward
- At the conclusion of the ride there will be a post ride discussion for a question and answer opportunity
- Open to existing Road Captains and RC candidates
- Next Welcome ride is planned for Friday, 2nd July. See calendar for details

Welcome Rides:

- These will be scheduled 1-2 times per month, weather permitting, and includes an ice cream stop
- Briefings will be covered in detail to ensure all riders have a complete understanding, followed by a question and answer opportunity
- These will vary with short and easy rides assisting members to feel comfortable and confident with group riding
- Open to all members, regardless of experience level
- Next Welcome ride is planned for 5 pm on Friday, 2 July, at All American HD. See the calendar for details

By offering RC Orientation Rides, the goal; is to assist our RC's and RC Candidates an opportunity to either build and/or refresh each member's skill set for group riding. The welcome Rides offer a similar benefit for all members, regardless of experience level. Finally, the combination of these two types of rides held monthly should build on the knowledge and confidence levels for our members, thus increasing both ride events and increased attendance. Adding to that, Gov Hogan has (1) lifted the outdoor mask mandate and ended outdoor dining restrictions, (2) lifted capacity limits on both outdoor and indoor venues, (3) ended the statewide mask mandate. It's been 14 months of restrictions, and many of us can agree that we might be a bit rusty, so now is the time to work at resuming our skill sets.

Safety Officer – Todd Brooks

- Topic for tonight is HYDRATION
- Drink plenty of water
- Build water breaks into your ride stops, will help you to keep hydrated

- Try to drink 8 oz of water before putting on your helmet, put water bottle in your tour pack for later.
- Things you can drink besides water, are Gatorade, propel, Pedialyte. Don't drink coffee or tea they will dehydrate you
- Other things you can do to keep hydrated are use a camelback hydration system, cooling vest. If you use a camelback put 2 frozen water bottles in the camelback to help keep your water cold.
