	 Safety info Riding in the Danger Zone: Leaves: Dry leaves are not really an issue. Wet leaves are very slippery Pine Needles are very slippery when dry or wet Intersections: Debris in the middle of the intersection where the air movement and vehicle tires push the rocks, screws, nails, tools This is most problematic area of the intersection when making left turns. Also in between right/left turn lanes where the stripe is. And don't forget most closely to the curb stripe whether on single lane (right side) or multi- lane roads (left and right side)
