Safety Doc Truesdale

Safety:

- 1. What year was the teardrop gas tank first introduced and still used today? 1924, It was used because of the lower seat height and increased sportiness of the motorcycle

- 3. How did the "Dyna" models get their name? A company-wide contest to name the newest FX variant. Employees submitted entries; marketing settled on its favorite. "Dyna Glide"

Basic riding formations: As we talk about in our pre-ride brief, staggered formation (hand signal) we ride in the left and right tire tracks. Two seconds from the person in front of you and 1 second from person in opposite tire track. Single file formation (hand signal) we ride 2 seconds from person in front of you.

How far is 2 seconds?

3 volunteers, demonstrated the actual distance of the 1-seconds distances below.

1 Second (Opposite lane) 30 mph= 44 fps
40 mph= 57 fps
2 seconds= 114 ft
50 mph= 73 fps
2 seconds= 146 ft
60 mph= 88 fps
2 seconds= 186 ft
70 mph= 102 fps
2 seconds= 202 ft

44 ft is approximately 5 bike lengths 57 ft is approximately 7 bike lengths 73 ft is approximately 9 bike lengths 88 ft is approximately 11 bike lengths 102 ft is approximately 13 bike lengths.

When riding pick a stationary object: Mailbox, telephone pole, sign, driveway. When the bike in front of you is at that spot, count One thousand 1, one thousand 2 and you should arrive at the same place. Does not matter what speed, or tire track you are in. The same principle applies for the bike in the other tire track One thousand 1 for 1 second interval.

It takes approximately 1.5 seconds to "See" > "Evaluate" > "Execute".
