A) 1940• 3) What year was the Infotainment system introduced/released? A) 2014• Tonight we're going to talk about brakes. For the demo we're going to assume: bike is in good working order, good tires, proper inflation, brake pads in good working order. 3 volunteers and a tape measure;<ul style="list-style-type: none">• At 20 mph it will take 20 ft to come to a complete stop once you apply the brakes (<u>after</u> "SEE - see, evaluate execute")• At 30 mph it will take 40 ft to come to a complete stop (after SEE)• At 40 mph it will take 80 ft to come to a complete stop (after SEE)• At 70 mph it will take 246 ft to come to a complete stop (after SEE)• The faster you are going, the longer it will take. The newer bikes with ABS, RDRS and other enhancements are not as dangerous;• Moisture in the brake fluid is also a concern, if there is more than 3% of moisture the fluid should be changed. Have you ever tried to move your bike on a cold day and the brake feels like a brick, it just won't move that's because the moisture in the brake fluid has "frozen"• Gigi will post his handout to the chapter website for those who'd like to review more detail
