Safety Officer – Todd Brooks

- Whats the safest state to ride in? Montana. Montana's rate was the lowest at 0.75. Notice that the southern states have a higher rate. 1st is Mississippi and 2nd is Texas.
- In the local area Maryland has a rate of 7.27 equal to Arkansas as the 12th and 13th most danagerous states. Virginia comes in at 21st with a rate of 6.03.
- Possibily the southern states have a higher ratio because of a longer riding season.
